# Russian Narrative to Date



- A focus on misrepresenting Latvian/Baltic history
- Claims of Nazism/Facism (“Blue Division”)
- Poor behavior of eFP members
- eFP/NATO poses an offensive threat
- Misspent funds by LVA/NATO nations in LVA
- Trending to *slightly* distorted “facts”
- Very limited during 2<sup>nd</sup> Rotation

1. No crimes (major or otherwise)
2. Trust Maintained
3. Multi-National Cohesion Enhanced
4. Behaved Professional
5. Readiness Mandate Reinforced



## 5 Things We Will Not Do (Paths to Mission Failure)

1. Major crimes, specifically those of a sexual nature
2. Loss of trust, particularly through a lack of transparency or dishonesty
3. Break of cohesion (multi-national)
4. Unprofessional behaviour
5. Violation of readiness mandate

# Strategic vs Tactical Deterrence

1. Defining Deterrence.
2. BG ability to act in “grey area”.

5. Media exposure. Passive not sufficient, must be active.
